

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO PARK AT HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL

- Parking at Heritage High School is a privilege not a right and is available on a <u>limited basis</u>. Consideration will be given <u>only to seniors and students in academic programs</u> where transportation is not provided. Parking passes do not allow students to park at the New Horizons campus.
- Applications for parking on campus may be obtained from the main office.
- If you are approved for a parking permit, there is a \$40.00, non-refundable fee for the window tag, payable to Heritage High School.
- It is imperative that you read the regulations on this application and the regulations in the NNPS Parent-Student Handbook; you are expected to <u>abide by them</u>. Failure to comply will cause your parking privilege to be suspended or terminated.

PARKING INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS FOR HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL

- No one is allowed to park on campus without properly securing a parking permit and displaying it on the mirror.
- Tags are **not** transferable from one individual to another.
- Students who need to drive an *alternate vehicle* must submit, in writing one (1) day in advance, a note from the parent/guardian. This note should include a *phone number* where the parent/guardian may be reached for confirmation before permission to drive a different vehicle. In the event that advanced notice cannot be given, student must notify the main office immediately upon arrival to HHS. <u>Failure to notify will result in loss of driving privileges.</u>
- The **speed limit** on campus is **5 miles per hour** and will be **strictly** enforced. Parking tag can be revoked if you drive over speed limit or recklessly on school property.
- Attendance and punctuality are important elements for success. More than six (6) tardies, excused or unexcused, and/or more than five (5) unexcused absences per semester will result in suspension or termination of parking privileges. Attendance will be checked periodically throughout the school year to assure compliance.
- Upon entering the parking lot, you must park, lock, and exit your vehicle. Students are not permitted to return to their vehicle at any time during the school day without administrative approval.
- Only seniors with <u>off-campus passes</u> are permitted to leave school grounds during lunch. Any vehicle leaving campus with occupants without an off-campus pass will result in the driver's loss of parking privileges.
- Student vehicles are subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion to suspect weapons, drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband.² The School retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property.
- PARK AT YOUR OWN RISK. Heritage High School and the Newport News School Division are not liable for vandalism, theft, accidents, etc. Each will be treated as if your vehicle was parked on a public street. *The school does not provide insurance to cover such losses*. You may place a claim with your personal insurance carrier.
- Parking permits provide the privilege of on-campus parking on a first come basis. It does not guarantee a parking place on campus unless you pay for a priority space.
- Student must present vehicle registration card, valid driver's license, and proof of insurance before a parking tag is issued.
- Juniors (Grade 11) will be considered for parking privileges for special situations, approval of which will be determined by the Assistant Principal of Operations.
- A replacement parking tag is \$20.00; a new tag will void the original tag issued.
- Early College Program Students will pay \$20.

All school rules and regulations apply everywhere on school grounds and at school functions off campus.
